Why Montevideo??

Montevideo is the main access to the **“Hidrovía Paraná – Paraguay”**. Furthermore, a natural harbor under the scheme only free port in the region, which facilitates the logistics operations.

Due to its geographical location, Montevideo Port is connected to the main highways, airlines, railway lines, maritime and river routes of the region.

It is located in the Paraguay-Paraná-Río de la Plata Watergate, constituting the main hub of the region serving international clients.

This allows a higher speed for the transport of incoming or out-going goods from the harbour, towards or from different countries of the region.

POLO LOGÍSTICO PORTUARIO also has access to the Uruguayan and regional railway system.
